Variety;	100% Riesling	
Fruit Source;	Polish Hill River in the Clare Valley. Named "Trillians" after the hills the winery is situated on.	
Vintage;	An earlier vintage than some previous years with grapes being at maturity almost 4 weeks sooner than anticipated. The early heat in November gave an abundant leaf cover that ensured the 'sugar factory' was adequate to maintain the long even ripening that gives greatness in wines at Polish Hill River.
